Subject: Public Health Scotland Target Operating Model 2.0

Purpose

This paper asks the Programme Board to **approve** Public Health Scotland's Target Operating Model 2.0.

Background

Since TOM 1.1 (the last version released) we have

- reviewed all of the 72 written submissions to the TOM engagement in February and March
- invited commission and project leads to contribute or comment on specific sections

As a result, we have

- significantly redrafted section 5, 6, 7 and 8
- made changes to section 2, 3 and, to reflect the programme board's decision and subsequent action, section 4
- added appendices A to C

Clearly, as we are still developing Public Health Scotland, working on its location, its shared service partnerships and how its finances will work, the final sections of the TOM are shorter than earlier section. Over the next months as these pieces of work develop, this will change.

Next Steps

Once approved, we will start to communicate the contents of TOM 2.0 to staff. Because of the document's length and technical nature, we will produce summary versions which will be more readable than the full TOM 2.0.

Recommendation

The programme board is asked to approve TOM 2.0.
